

The Worship Committee met on Wednesday, August 19, 2009 at 5:00 PM.

Present were: Kay Ball, Dave Gemmill, Allison Fisher, Clint Mauk, Ken Pepin, Paul Tait, and Mary Tudor.

The meeting opened at 5:00 p.m. with prayer.

The issue of **scheduling for Sunday ministries** was discussed at length. It was decided that the Worship Committee will oversee this activity. Clint Mauk will continue to schedule the Eucharistic Ministers. Mary Tudor will schedule the Lectors. Dave Gemmill will schedule the Ushers/Greeters/Coffee Hosts group. (Marge Hunter was pleased to relinquish this duty to the committee while she recuperates.) An attempt will be made to set up schedules for three months at a time. The schedules will then rotate in the same order.

There are three separate lay ministry licenses within the church – Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, and Worship Leaders. All licenses need to be renewed by November, 2009.

Founders' Day will be celebrated on Sunday, September 20. The Eucharistic Liturgy for that Sunday will be from the original Book of Common Prayer that was ratified by the church in 1789. The Senior Warden luncheon will also be held that day.

The Children's' Ministry Team is trying to incorporate the children into the worship service to a greater extent. Beginning this Sunday School year, they will be in the church for the initial prayers of the service, then leave for classes, and return for the Eucharist.

The meeting adjourned with prayer at 6:10 p.m.
