

The Worship Committee met on Wednesday, February 18, 2009 from 5:00 to 6:00 PM.

Meeting opened with prayer at 5:00 p.m.

Speakers for the Lenten programs on ethics have been obtained except for the session on the judiciary and ethics. Paul is still waiting to hear from Judge Kelsey.

Lenten Suppers will be simple. The Worship Committee will host the first one and serve a variety of soups and bread.

The **Ash Wednesday** service will be a Holy Eucharist service with no supper scheduled. Soup and bread suppers will be held the other Wednesday evenings in Lent from 6:00 to about 7:30 p.m.

Sunday Lenten services will include the Penitential Order and the Decalogue (Ten Commandments) as well as the Anointing of the Sick after each service (8:00 and 10:00). The Eucharistic ministers will assist as needed. There will be no procession.

Holy Week coincides with Spring Break this year. We will have a Christian Seder meal on Maundy Thursday, followed by a Vigil through the night and into Good Friday. There will be an evening service on Good Friday.

Activities for an **Easter Vigil** were discussed. Repeating the progressive dinner idea from last year was considered, with a part of dinner and part of the ritual service at each home.

More **Eucharistic ministers** are still needed. Clint had several volunteers for Lay Readers.

The next meeting of the Worship Committee will be Wednesday, March 18, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.
