

The Worship Committee met on Wednesday, December 16, 2009 at 5:30 PM.

The meeting opened at 5:30 p.m. with prayer.

Assignment of Sunday Ministries was clarified. Clint Mauk schedules Eucharistic Ministers, Mary Tudor schedules Lectors, and David Gemmill schedules ushers/greeters, coffee hosts, and flower deliveries. Clint will continue to train lectors.

Budget increase was approved at \$500.00 for 2010. Because music is an integral part of our services, music should be a separate line item in the future. (to include piano tuning, substitute organists, etc.)

The **noise level** in the Narthex before the 10:00 o'clock service was addressed and has improved. Consensus is it will be an ongoing issue needing attention.

A longer pause for added intercessions during the **Prayers of the People** is desired, at both services. Printed directions in the bulletin have helped. Consensus is that we have a good start and need to continue to model the behavior.

The **Christmas services** will remain the same with the addition of an improvisational sermon at the early service on Christmas Eve.

A **service of Lessons and Carols** will be held at 10:00 on December 27th, the Sunday after Christmas.

January is filled with the Annual Meeting, two baptisms, and the Taste of St. Tim's ministries fair.

Ideas for **Lenten programs** were discussed. Mindy will confer with Catherine Huber regarding programming.

New robes for the Eucharistic Ministers were discussed. It was agreed that the church purchase four albs with cinctures in varying sizes with the option for purchasing by individuals. Judy Snyder will measure and decide on sizes.

The meeting adjourned with prayer at 6:30 p.m.
