

The Worship Committee met on Wednesday, April 21, 2010 at 5:30 PM.

Mother's Day is May 9th. Kay will order 75 red carnations. The plan is to have the children hand them out to all the women present, as Ken suggested.

An **Evensong** service will be Sunday, May 16 at 5:00. The combined choirs of St. Tim's and St. Michael's will sing. Choirs will arrive at 3:30. St. Michael's people will vest in the library. The fellowship committee will host a reception after the service. Mary Tudor will assign a lector and Dave Gemmill will assign ushers.

Pentecost Sunday is on May 23 and will not coincide with the **Youth Service**, which is still in the planning stages. The focus on Pentecost will be a celebration of our ministries. Each will receive a red ribbon as they enter and all those involved in various ministries will be asked to stand and be recognized.

Follow-up is needed on the status of orders for **Bibles** to be made available and for **Albs** for the Eucharistic Ministers.

Introduction of visitors was discussed. Consensus is to continue in the current manner – included with the announcements at the end of the service. Visitors are greeted at the entrance and also receive a 'visitor's bag' which is kept current.
