

The Worship Committee met on Wednesday, February 17, 2010 at 5:30 PM.

The meeting opened at 5:30 p.m. with prayer.

Lenten Programming for the Souper Suppers was discussed. The Worship Committee is hosting the first one on February 24. Menu assignments were made and a list of potential movies for discussion was generated. The list includes: The Blind Side; Walle; and District Nine. UP will be shown after the 10:00 service on Sunday for those interested.

The **Ministry Fair** generated two new names for the Worship Committee. Names were forwarded to David Gemmill. Having a Google Map from the church to the home of the person receiving the altar flowers will be helpful to the deliverers.

Holy Week activities were firmed up. The Gospel for **Palm Sunday** will again use the speaking parts from the congregation as we did last year. Those who are interested in learning to make palm crosses will be invited to a workshop on March 27.

Maundy Thursday activities will begin with a Christian Seder meal, followed by the Maundy Thursday service and stripping of the altar, followed directly by the Prayer Vigil, which will last through the night and end at noon on Good Friday. A larger group is needed to set up and cook for the Seder meal and the Vigil needs more active promotion.

There will be an ecumenical **Good Friday** service at Grace United Methodist at noon and a Way of the Cross service at St. Tim's on Good Friday evening.

For the **Easter Vigil on Saturday**, we will again hold a Progressive Dinner. Host families are needed and an attempt will be made to host all in one general area of town.

There will be three baptisms on **Easter Sunday**.

For the future – There is a **parish drama on the Life and Death of Jesus** that may be used in place of the usual Passion Narrative on Palm Sunday or presented during Holy Week. Ken has the details. There is a need to begin preparations for Holy Week earlier in the year to provide more time for planning.

The meeting adjourned with prayer at 6:30 p.m.
